



LESSON PACKAGE TERMS

Lesson packages are a necessity for riders with long-term goals.

- Lesson packages are the only way to reserve and maintain your lesson time slot each week as well as gaining the discount of \$10 off per lesson.
- Payments for lesson packages are accepted by credit card or ACH automatic withdrawal from your bank account on the first of each month paid in advance. (i.e. July 1st pays for July lessons)
- There are no refunds on lesson packages - **no exceptions**
- Lesson packages must be used **in the month they are purchased** and cannot be held or rolled over for a different month **under any circumstances**.
- Makeup lessons must be scheduled and completed within the same month, and do not roll over to the next month.
- Lesson packages are non-transferable and must be used in their entirety by the person they were purchased for.
- If you need to reschedule one or more lessons, please know that Conquest will accommodate, if at all possible. However, we cannot guarantee time slot availability will match with your schedule, so please try to maintain the schedule originally setup at the time of lesson package purchase.
- 24-Hour cancellation notice still applies to each lesson, **no exception**. Lessons rescheduled or cancelled with less than 24-hour notice are considered “missed” and cannot be made up – **NO EXCEPTIONS**.
- If there are five weeks in the month, a makeup lesson will not be granted for the missed lesson **NO EXCEPTIONS** – whether it be by the student or Conquest Farms. This is a “free” lesson by the barn as a bonus to our clients. If it needs to be missed **FOR ANY REASON**, it will **NOT** be rescheduled.
- ALL Lesson times are posted in your package (i.e. 30-minute, 60 minutes...etc.) Any help needed for tacking and untacking will come out of your lesson time. Those that can tack up on their own, **WITH THE PERMISSION OF THEIR TRAINER**, should arrive 30 minutes before their lesson time to groom, tack up, and be mounted on their horse at the start of their lesson time.
- Riding lessons are rain or shine, unless dangerous weather such as a severe storm, tropical storm, extreme temperatures, or hurricane are forecasted. In those instances, Conquest Farms will reach out regarding rescheduling. If a riding lesson is simply rained out, it will continue in the form of horsemanship.
- If for any reason the student chooses not to ride, they can opt for a horsemanship lesson instead.
